

TIMESLIPS TIPS:

RESTORE ALL WINDOWS TO DEFAULT SIZE AND POSITION

Timeslips displays various messages which are difficult to identify, but restoring all windows to default size and position will clear the problem. Following are some errors which can be fixed with this utility:

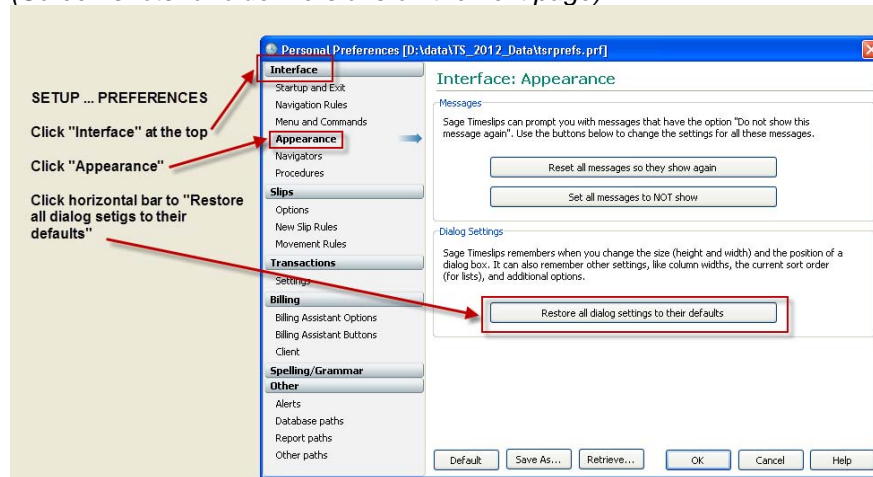
- “Not positioned on an existing record...”
- Report hangs when printing
- Windows column sizes are not correct
- Missing toolbars

Procedure:

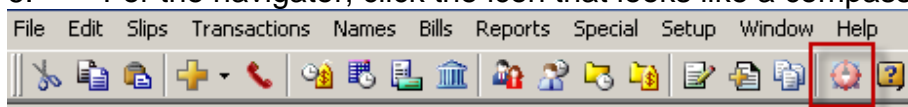
1. From the top menu bar, click WINDOW ... CLOSE ALL
2. From the top menu bar, click SETUP ... PREFERENCES
3. Click “INTERFACE” and then click “Appearance”
4. Click the option to restore all dialog settings to their defaults.

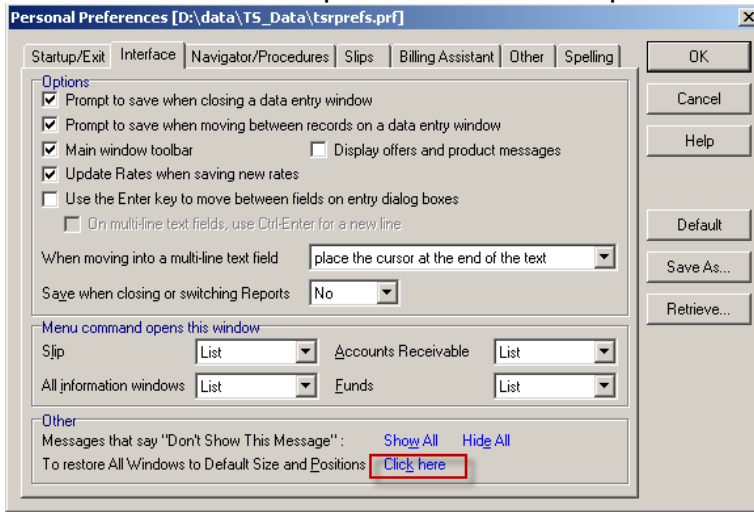
