Using Roaming Profiles / Multiple Desktops With Timeslips

Question

I have Timeslips users who share workstations. Each time a new user logs into Timeslips I am forced to clear a licenses. Is there any way to avoid this and allow multiple users on one workstation?

Answer

Follow the directions below to configure workstations to allow access for multiple users working with Timeslips.

Timeslips must be closed prior to proceeding with the following steps.

*****Note:** It is always recommended a backup be made prior to making any changes to the Timeslips program or data.

1. Log Onto the Workstation as the Administrator of that machine.
2. Locate the Timeslips Station Administrator by going to **Start; Programs; Timeslips**.
3. Once in the Station Administrator go to the **Options** menu and select **Licenses in use**. Clear all license.
4. Choose **Options** again and select **Remove Current Station** . Click **Yes** to the removal of the current station.
5. Log off the workstation as administrator and log back in as one of the Timeslips users
6. Go to station Administrator and repeat steps 3 and 4 to clear license and remove the current station.
7. Log off the computer once again and login as the workstation administrator.
8. Run all Timeslips executables (Timeslips Program, TSimport, Report Designer, Station Administrator etc.)
9. Log off the workstation as administrator and log back in as one of the Timeslips users.
10. Run all Timeslips executables once again.

11. Repeat steps 10 thru 11 for each user of Timeslips
